Milo

Milo is back for another season with session one resulting in over 50 kids aged between four and ten adorning Shark Park.

The program runs for ten weeks in total- five sessions pre-Christmas (13 Nov, 20 Nov, 27 Nov, 4 Dec, 11 Dec) and five post-Christmas (29 Jan, 5 Feb, 12 Feb, 19 Feb and 26 Feb).

The program usually costs \$75 per child; however we want this program to be accessible to all. The club has come up with several different options to make sure we can make this happen.

As a result of receiving a grant in the off season, the first 30 girls who register to participate, the program will be fully subsidised meaning they can participate in the program and will receive a Milo Pack which consists of a backpack, hat, t-shirt, ball, bat etc.

The first 15 new participants to the program will be fully subsidised by the club meaning they can participate in the program and will receive a Milo Pack which consists of a backpack, hat, t-shirt, ball, bat etc.

For returning participants or those who don't make it into the grant category of 15 new participant category, there are two options for you:

Option 1

The child can participate in the program free of charge however they will not receive a Milo pack. This has been popular with many of our returning participants as their tops still fit them from last season.

Option 2

Pay a one off fee of \$75 which covers the cost of the Milo pack.

Please note that the pack is not a necessity to take part in the program. Participants can wear any sporting attire they like and the bat, ball etc. is not used during the sessions.
