Milo

This entry level program involves activities that teach kids the basic skills to play cricket and from what we saw last week, it's going to produce some fine Baysy Park cricketers in the years to come!

T20 Blast

This season sees the introduction of the Milo T20 Blast competition for kids aged between approximately 8 and 12 years.

It is much shorter than traditional cricket, with a maximum playing time of 90 minutes. Each participant gets an equal turn of batting, bowling and fielding regardless of their ability. They get the opportunity to play games of T20 cricket, whilst developing fundamental skills.

The matches are played on a smaller field allowing parents to get close to all the action and with several games taking place on the same oval at the same time it creates an action packed fun atmosphere where every kid is involved.

Instead of sitting waiting to bat, the children take part in a Skills Zone, where games and activities help them develop vital cricket skills.

The program is professionally delivered and it's aligned with the KFC T20 Big Bash League!
